MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING & REGULAR SESSION
OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
Tuesday, August 25, 2026 -6:00 PM

Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., Alderman Steele then led the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Alderman Clemons to approve seconded by Alderman Driggers and the motion was carried by unanimous voice vote.

Approval of Minutes: Work Session July 21, 2026; Alderman Larsen made a motion to approve, the motion was seconded by Alderman Clemons and was carried by unanimous voice vote

Regular Session July 28, 2026; Alderman Driggers made a motion to approve, the motion was seconded by Alderman Steele and was carried by unanimous voice vote

Approval of Financials: July 2026; Alderman Larsen made a motion to approve, the motion was seconded by Alderman Driggers and the motion carried by unanimous voice vote

1. Ordinance #6 of 2026 – TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, LOUISIANA, RELATING TO ABANDONED AND INOPERATIVE VEHICLES (Introduce and set for Public Hearing on September 29, 2026) Clerk, T. Searcy read the Ordinance by title, there were no public comments and Mayor Davis called for a motion. A motion was made by Alderman Driggers, seconded by Alderman Larsen to introduce and set for Public Hearing. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote
2. Resolution #7 of 2026 – TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN LETTERS OF ENGAGEMENT WITH COOK AND MOREHART FOR SERVICES TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL AUDIT AND REVIEW THE REQUIRED PROCEDURES AS PROVIDED BY THE SCHEDULE OF THE STATE AGREED UPON PROCEDURES (SAUP). Clerk T. Searcy read the resolution by title, Mayor Davis advised that these were yearly recurring documents then called for discussion or motion. A motion was made by Alderman Steele, seconded by Alderman Adcock. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
3. Resolution #8 of 2026 – TITLE: A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL OF ASSIGNMENT OF THAT CERTAIN OIL, GAS AND OTHER LIQUID OR GASEOUS MINERAL LEASE BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, LESSOR, AND MARK A. O'NEAL & ASSOCIATES, INC., LESSEE. Clerk T. Searcy read the resolution by title, Mayor Davis advised again that this was just a lease then called for discussion or motion. A motion was made by Alderman Larsen, seconded by Alderman Driggers. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
4. Approval of reappointments to the Caddo Fire District Board of Commissioners as recommended by Mayor Justin Davis. A motion was made by Alderman Driggers, seconded by Alderman Adcock. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
