MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION
OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
TUESDAY, August 18, 2026 6:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Davis, Aldermen Clemons, Steele, Driggers, and Larsen, Clerk Tiffany Searcy, Police Lieutenant Chris Faris and members of the public.

Absent: Alderman Adcock

Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Steele led the invocation and pledge of allegiance.

Staff Reports: 1) No use of force in July 2) DWI checkpoint resulted in 3 arrests 3) National Night Out is scheduled for Oct 6 in the park from 5-8pm.

Code Enforcement officer David Searcy introduced new hire Kevin Dunn to the board.

Mayor's Report: 1) Tank lining job is complete 2) Gave update about capital outlay money 3) Updated the calendar of upcoming events; Food Truck Night, Greenwood Feed & Seed open house; Chamber Pancake breakfast; Trunk R Treat and Pioneer Festival.

Approval of Financials for July 2026; there was no discussion from the board

1. Ordinance #6 of 2026 – TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, LOUISIANA, RELATING TO ABANDONED AND INOPERATIVE VEHICLES (Introduce and set for Public Hearing on September 29, 2026) Read by title and Mayor Davis gave details on the ordinance. There was a brief discussion by the board.
2. Resolution #7 of 2026 – TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN LETTERS OF ENGAGEMENT WITH COOK AND MOREHART FOR SERVICES TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL AUDIT AND REVIEW THE REQUIRED PROCEDURES AS PROVIDED BY THE SCHEDULE OF THE STATE AGREED UPON PROCEDURES (SAUP) Mayor Davis explained this is the normal yearly audit paperwork. There was no discussion nor questions from the board.
3. Resolution #8 of 2026 – TITLE: A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL OF ASSIGNMENT OF THAT CERTAIN OIL, GAS AND OTHER LIQUID OR GASEOUS MINERAL LEASE BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, LESSOR, AND MARK A. O'NEAL & ASSOCIATES, INC., LESSEE Mayor Davis explained that the Town is not selling mineral rights but are simply leasing to an operator to bring in monthly income. There was no discussion nor questions from the board.
4. Approval of reappointments to the Caddo Fire District Board of Commissioners as recommended by Mayor Justin Davis. Mayor Davis stated this would be a two-year term. There was no discussion nor questions from the board.
