MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION
OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
Tuesday, December 23, 2025 - 6:00 PM

Present: Mayor Davis, Aldermen Steele, Adcock, and Larsen, Clerk Tiffany Searcy, Chief of Police Shayne Gibson and members of the public.

Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m. Alderman Steele led the invocation and pledge of allegiance.

Staff Reports: Chief Gibson reported 1) No use of force in November 2) Relayed his appreciation for the Community's help with Operation Santa Clause; they were able to help 50 families and seniors

1. Ordinance No. 10 of 2025

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SCHEDULE FOR 2026 WORK SESSION AND REGULAR SESSION MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD (Introduce and Set for Public Hearing on January 27th at 6:00 pm). Mayor Davis pointed out that the dates are included in the packet. There was no discussion from the board.

2. Ordinance No 11 of 2025

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, LOUISIANA, TO RECOUP COSTS AND ANY EXPENSE INCURRED BY ENFORCING LA R.S. 33:5062 WEED CUTTING, BY ADDING ASSOCIATED COSTS TO THE PROPERTY TAXES DUE (Introduce and Set for Public Hearing on January 27th at 6:00 pm). Mayor Davis explained that this Ordinance will help to pay the Town back. There was no discussion from the board.

3. Resolution No 14 of 2025

TITLE: A RESOLUTION SETTING THE RATES ON THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEE SCHEDULE. Mayor Davis explained that we need to adjust fees to keep up with current standards. Amounts in black will come to the Town and amounts in red will go to the inspector. The only new "exception" is to add re-roof, which will have law changes in 2026. There was no discussion from the board.
