MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION
OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
Tuesday, February 17, 2026 - 6:00 PM

Present: Mayor Davis, Aldermen Clemons, Steele, Adcock, Driggers, and Larsen, Clerk Tiffany Searcy, Chief of Police Shayne Gibson and members of the public.

Absent: None

Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Steele led the invocation and pledge of allegiance.

Staff Reports: Chief Gibson reported 1) One use of force in January 2) We are in need of Love the Boot week volunteers on April 18 3) Ofc Harrison has started the refresher course at the academy 4) Ofc Trammell is leaving the department to be replaced by return Ofc Anderson.

Mayor's Report: 1) Updates to the zoning maps are almost complete 2) Plans haven't been decided on the Hwy 80 clearing area 3) Water usage is down to 368,000 gal/day which is on the low side of normal 4) Sewer plant upgrade project is still in the works 5) Easter in the Park is set for April 4 6) Love the Boot week is being organized by Alderman Clemons for April 18 starting at 7am.

1. Resolution No 2 of 2026

TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO COMPLETE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM OFFICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, COMMUNITY WATER ENRICHMENT FUND (CWEF). Mayor Davis spoke to the board on the intended use of the \$35,000 to reline the water tank. There was no discussion from the board.

2. Resolution No 3 of 2026

TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO COMPLETE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM OFFICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, LOUISIANA GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE FUND (LGAP). Mayor Davis spoke to the board on the intended use of the \$35,000 for renovations to the Pioneer Building. Alderman Larsen and Mayor Davis had a discussion about inviting the community to help.

Alderman Driggers voiced his appreciation for the amazing leadership to the Town in general during the ice storm.
