

**TOWN OF GREENWOOD
MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION
OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
Tuesday, January 20, 2026 - 6:00 PM**

Present: Mayor Davis, Aldermen Clemons, Steele, Driggers, and Larsen, Clerk Tiffany Searcy, Chief of Police Shayne Gibson and members of the public.

Absent: Alderman Adcock

Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Alderman Steele led the invocation and pledge of allegiance.

Staff Reports: Chief Gibson reported 1) No use of force in December 2) Hired Rex Harrison full time officer on Dec 29, 2025 3) Ofc Oswalt is currently working a litter grant along with assisting Alderman Clemons with the Love the Boot Clean-Up day scheduled April 18; volunteers are welcomed.

Mayor's Report: 1) With the possible upcoming Winter Weather; we have prepared and have a plan in place should we lose power; urges residents to be mindful of continuous dripping of pipes so to not over work the plant
Alderman Driggers advised of Breakfast and Bingo to be held Feb 7 at 11am in the Pioneer Building.

Approval of Financials for December 2025; there was no discussion from the board.

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, LOUISIANA, TO RECOUP COSTS AND ANY EXPENSE INCURRED BY ENFORCING LA R.S. 33:5062 WEED CUTTING, BY ADDING ASSOCIATED COSTS TO THE PROPERTY TAXES DUE (Final Reading and Passage); there was no discussion from the board.

4. Resolution No 1 of 2026

TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD AND THE LOUISIANA STATE MINERAL AND ENERGY BOARD TO NOMINATE PROPERTY FOR STATE AGENCY MINERAL LEASE; Mayor Davis explained that the Town owns 8 acres of interest and the terms would be for 3 years; there was no discussion from the board.
